

Week 3	Finalize water proofing Walk the client through tile lay out Start tiling
Week 4	Finish tiling Order customized shower screen after tile finish Fit off bathroom Paint ceiling and door Final clean and hand over Issue client with warranty certificates

Our guarantee

- 7 year waterproofing warranty as per Australian Standards
- 12 months minor defect warranty
- Fixture warranties will be as per the supplier's warranty provisions

This applies to complete bathroom renovations where Nu Trend have prepared the floors, walling, waterproofing and tiling. Minor defects include things such as grout or paint touch ups, loose tap nuts etc which we will rectify free of charge. We test and commission all work and walk through everything with you before our final visit however you will be spending a lot more time using the bathroom so you may notice something that wasn't evident during hand over.

Quotation details

Will the management fee cover the entire project from start to finish?

Will there be parking available, if so, what type?

Protective drop sheeting to suit the property and special items that require protection.

Will we be providing removal of rubbish and demolition materials?

Will a permit be required for a skip bin or are there any noise restrictions for things like a skip bin?

Will the existing sub floor be used?



Will the existing wall structures remain or structural changes needed?

Will the concrete slab need to be scanned for any reason?

Will you require electrical works?

Will you require plumbing works?

Will wall rendering be required?

Will fibro cement sheeting for the walls be required?

Will the existing ceiling remain or be replaced?



Will there be cornice or a different style finish on the ceiling?

Will gyprock or sheeting/setting/sanding be required?

Will a carpenter be needed?

Will any architraves be needed?

Will there be a wall niche?

Will there be special fire rated ceiling, walls, doors or floors?

Are there smoke alarms that require disabling?



Will painting be required?

Is waterproofing and priming included? If yes, will Waterproofing Certificate be included?

Is tiling and grouting included?

Will there be any mitre tile finishing?

Will there be any special tiling finishes?

Will the customer be supplying fixtures / fittings / tiles / accessories?

Terms & conditions

Renovating

We will do everything possible to ensure

your renovation project runs smoothly and disruption is minimised. Although it will mean there is equipment, tools, debris and dust in your home, that is just part of the renovation process.

Access

We understand this is your home and place of

rest, however, we will need access at different times of the day during the project period to ensure we are can maintain our high quality standards. Being able to manage the project with limited restrictions will ensure a better final product.

Exclusions

Our team will endeavour to be as careful and cautious as possible when renovating your property. Although sometimes there will be unavoidable construction damage that can occur due to vibrations from power tools or equipment. Whether this occurs will depend on the quality of the construction of the property.

If this does occur, we will provide a quotation for rectification repairs.

Our quotation has allowed for minor upgrades to services in your bathroom that we can visibly see during inspection. If we do discover more major plumbing issues or illegal installation of plumbing or electricals

we will report this to you asap with a quoted solution.

Our quotations do not allow for things like asbestos removal and if there are hazards such as this that are discovered we will pause work and quote accordingly before proceeding.

If there is an unforseen issue that arises we will stop all works and gain your approval with quoted, documented reports prior to continuation of works.

Generally, we are working with existing wall structures, please take into consideration that walls will not be 100 percent level and true unless the entire room structure was demolished and rebuilt. In some instances, these variations can cause unforeseen issues and we

will advise best steps and possible rectification steps if they are discovered.

Our quotation allows for a standard bathroom demolition. If we discover there are elements left from previous renovations such as tiling over tiling, we will stop and quote for the variation in scope of work due to the time and extra rubbish removal required.

During drop sheeting and the duration of the project, we go out of our way to protect the property walls, floors and all areas. On rare occasions drop sheeting tape can pull old paint or a small dent or scratch on a floor board may be found. This will be treated as a variation as we have done our best to prevent damage from occurring.



For a smooth project

• Please only speak with Rick or Robert regarding times, changes or decisions regarding your project. This will mean we can manage things efficiently for you considering there could be many new faces on the site at different days and times.

- All changes must be confirmed and agreed to via eMail.
- We will provide a consistent flow of updates/photos throughout your project.

• Your quote will include photos prior to project commencement to ensure that we have not caused any accidental damage that needs to be repaired.

- All fixtures and fittings must be on site as early as possible with a clear printed spec sheet prior to start date.
- · We need a location to store materials and cut tiles.
- We will endeavour to remain clean however this is construction and there will be unavoidable dust.

• We do try to honour our estimated time of completion however there may be a delay due to weather, parts, unexpected variations etc so it is important that we work together to understand if any potential delays will occur.
